




2b Slide mounting bracket notch over screw heads.




2C Install next two screws in center notch of mounting bracket; tighten all screws.



INSTALLING CABLE FOR FIELD TERMINATION 4.




Strip Lengths for 1U, 2U, 3U Housings



3 Lift plunger on internal strain-relief assembly. Push bracket to rear to disengage ridged flange on underside and remove it from the housing.




30 Set tray and strain-relief assembly on work surface for next operations.



4.2. Sheath Retention




